- 5. CONFIDENTIALITY. The Parties agree to keep the terms and conditions of this Agreement and the fact of its execution confidential, except as may be necessary to enforce it or as required by law.
- 6. NO ADMISSION OF LIABILITY. It is agreed to by both Parties that there is no admission of liability, guilt, wrongdoing, or any other recognition or acknowledgment by any Party.
- 7. GOVERNING LAW. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws located in the state where the Dispute occurred, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law provisions.
- 8. SEVERABILITY. If any term, clause, or provision of this Agreement is held invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 9. ADDITIONAL TERMS & CONDITIONS.
- **10.ENTIRE AGREEMENT**. This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the Parties concerning the subject matter mentioned hereof and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings, whether written or oral, concerning the subject matter hereof.
- **11. AMENDMENT**. This Agreement may only be amended in writing and signed by both Parties.
