RIGHT TO REVOKE AND METHOD TO REVOKE DEED.

Before the Transferor's death, the Transferor has the right to revoke this Deed.

Under the Uniform Real Property Transfer on Death Act, an instrument is effective to revoke a recorded Transfer on Death Deed, or any part of it, only if such revocatory instrument:

- 1. Is one of the following:
 - A. A Transfer on Death Deed that revokes the Deed or part of the Deed expressly or by inconsistency;
 - B. An instrument of revocation that expressly revokes the Deed or part of the Deed; or
 - C. An inter vivos Deed that expressly revokes the Transfer on Dead Deed or part of the Deed; and
- 2. Is acknowledged by the transferor after the acknowledgment of the Deed being revoked and recorded before the transferor's death, in the public records in the Office of the Clerk of the County Commission of the County where the Deed being revoked is recorded.

After this Transfer on Death Deed is recorded, it can be revoked only by an effective revocatory instrument recorded prior to the death of the Transferor and may not be revoked by a revocatory act taken against or on the original or a copy of the recorded Transfer on Death Deed. The execution and recordation of the Transfer on Death Deed does not limit the effect of an inter vivos transfer of the property.

At the death of the Transferor, the Beneficiary takes the property subject to all exceptions, reservations, restrictions, easements, covenants, rights of way, conveyances, encumbrances, assignments, contracts, mortgages, liens and other interests to which the property is subject at the Transferor's death.

DECLARATION OF CONSIDERATION OR VALUE.

The Transferor declares that pursuant to West Virginia Code §36-12-9 et seq., this Transfer on Death Deed is exempt from the payment of excise tax on the privilege of transferring real estate for the reason that no interest in the property is at the time of recording being passed to any beneficiary of the Deed, and the Deed remains revocable until the death of the Transferor.
